#### **MUSIC MINISTRY**

The music ministry at St. John's provides sacred music in the form of hymns, songs, anthems, and other musical offerings at the parish's 9:00 All Saints Hall service and the 11:00 Historic Church service. There are opportunities formusicians of all ages and instruments to regularly participate in worship and other performances in the following ensembles:

#### St. John's Choir

The adult choir sings weekly at the 11:00 a.m. Eucharist in the Historic Church from September to June, including the celebrations of Christmas and Holy Week. They sing a variety of choral music spanning several centuries and provide at least one anthem a week. Membership is open to high school students and older. Rehearsals are in the choir loft on Thursdays from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m., and on Sundays from 10:30 to 10:45 a.m. Contact: Justin Pechulis, jpechulis@stjohnsec.org

#### St. John's Ringers

The handbell choir generally rings once a month at the 11:00 a.m. Eucharist in the Historic Church, and on special days such as Christmas and Easter. Using their five-octave handbell set, they ring a variety of hymns and other musical selections. Membership is open to high school students and older who are comfortable reading music. Rehearsals are in the Music Office on the lower level of the church on Tuesdays from 6:30 to 7:30 p.m. Contact: Justin Pechulis, jpechulis@stjohnsec.org

#### **Instrumental Ensemble**

The instrumental ensemble generally plays once a month at the 11:00 a.m. Eucharist in the Historic Church, and on special days such as Christmas and Easter. The ensemble adds to hymn singing, choral anthems, and will also play on its own. It consists of woodwind, brass, string, and percussion instruments and membership is open to middle school students and older who have at least four years of experience on their instrument. Members are welcome participate as often as they are able, but there is no monthly requirement. Rehearsals are in the choir loft as announced on Tuesdays from 7:30 to 8:30 p.m. Contact: Ensemble@stjohnsec.org

#### All Saints Hall Band

The ASH Band plays every week at the 9:00 a.m. Eucharist in All Saints Hall from September to June. The band plays a variety of music from the past sixty years of praise and worship music, and consists of singers, guitarists, keyboardists, and drummers. Membership is open to all ages. Rehearsals take place on Sunday mornings before the service, from 8:00 to 8:45 a.m., with occasional weeknight rehearsals scheduled as needed.

#### **ASIAN MINISTRY**

Providing Korean worship services, pastoral care, and other support for Korean immigrants who want to live in God's grace and peace. A Korean-language service is held on Sundays at 10:30 a.m. in Resurrection Chapel and all are welcome. Holy Eucharist is celebrated on alternate Sundays. The service is followed by a meal and a Bible study. Joint services are held throughout the year with the English-speaking congregation.
